- Minimum two years pediatric experience, preferably including experience with children with Autism Spectrum Disorders

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assesses strengths and needs of children referred to the Therapy and Autism Services Programs through formal and/or informal evaluation
- Interprets results to parents and other team members so that they can understand
- Develops and implements an individualized program plan for each child in conjunction with parents and other professionals
- Consults with other team and community members regarding the child's program
- Re-evaluates the child's progress at regular intervals and update child's program as necessary
- Works as part of an interdisciplinary team in treatment approach
- Other related duties as assigned by the Therapy Program Supervisor.
