- Works with children and their families to implement therapeutic intervention developed by OTs, PTs and S-LPs;

- Consults with clinicians and other team members regarding a child's program, needs and progress, and assists in the modification of intervention plans as appropriate;
- Identifies and reports relevant changes and observations of a child's condition or performance, either verbally or in writing;
- Schedules appointments and therapy spaces as requested, as well as supports caseload management administration;
- Assists with maintenance and preparation of materials, toys and equipment;
- Other related duties as assigned by the Therapy Program Supervisor.
