JOB SUMMARY: Working within the Autism Services program the casual position will assist children to participate in the program activities of the child's behavior plan as developed by an interdisciplinary team.

DUTIES:

- Assists the child to participate in all program activities such as following the individualized plan as determined and directed by the interdisciplinary team.
- Collects data by observing and recording the child's progress on the Individual Program Plan.
- Prepares materials for child's program i.e., LessonPix materials, visual supports.
- Observes, records and reviews child's program with interdisciplinary team.
- Participates in team meetings by providing input on child's progress on the Individual Program Plan.

- Grade 12 education or equivalent.
- Six months recent related experience working with young children with developmental disabilities.
- Current First Aid Certificate.
- Valid driver's license and provide own transportation.
