



JOB POSTING: Casual Behaviour Interventionist

JOB SUMMARY: Working within the Autism Services Program (ASP), the casual behavior interventionist will assist children to participate in the program activities of the child's behavior plan as developed by an interdisciplinary team.

RESPONSIBLE TO: Autism Services Program Manager

EDUCATION, TRAINING & EXPERIENCE:

- Grade 12 diploma or equivalent
- Minimum six months recent related experience working with neurodivergent children and youth

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Effective verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to take directions and to follow planned programs
- Work cooperatively and effectively within a team
- Computer competence including Microsoft 365 applications
- Ability to adapt in dynamic and fast-paced environments

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide direct intervention both individually and within a group setting, to children/youth in the ASP, assisting them to participate in all program activities including following the individualized plan as determined and directed by the interdisciplinary team
- Prepare materials for the child/youth's program i.e., LessonPix materials or visual supports
- Collect data through observations and records the child/youth's progress on their Individual Program Plan, and sharing updates with the interdisciplinary team
- Work collaboratively within a team and actively participate in team meetings by providing input on child/youth's progress
- Other duties as assigned

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Required physical ability to perform the duties of the position, including (but not limited to) lifting, bending, sitting, standing and responding quickly as needed
- Consent to Criminal Record Check through the BC Criminal Records Review Program
- Valid driver's license and provide own transportation

DAYS & HOURS: Monday to Friday, 8:10 am to 4:10 pm. Some evening or weekend hours may be required occasionally, depending on program needs.
